

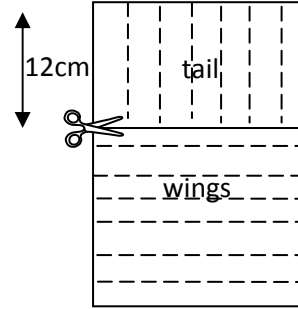
Make a pair of brilliant budgies!

You will need

colouring crayons, glue, scissors, 2 pieces of A4 paper, ruler and thread.

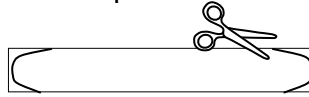
1. Colour in the budgies.
2. If you need help with the colours and patterns go to website gallery and check out the budgies there.
3. Cut along the straight solid lines around each budgie, then fold along the dashed line & glue the two sides of each body together.
4. Carefully cut round each budgie body.
5. To make the wings and tail you can colour in your own design on plain A4 paper or use coloured paper.

6. Measure 12 cm from top of the page and cut across.
The top section will form the tail and the bottom will be the wings.

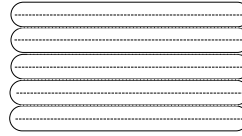


7. For the tail - fold the paper back and forth on itself, the first fold section needs to be about 2cm deep.

8. cut the corners off the folded paper into a rounded shape.



9. Unfold the paper and then refold each section in half, backwards and forwards in a fan style.



10. Repeat this with the remaining piece of paper to create wings,
11. folding from the longest edge of the paper.

12. Make slots in the body, an adult may need to help you.
13. Pass the folded tail and wing paper half way through the body and then fan each half out.
14. Use thread to hang up your budgie.
